



Camper Referral Program Guidelines 2010

Thank you for your help in telling the story of Camp Sea Gull and Camp Seafarer. We are excited that you recommended Sea Gull or Seafarer to another family. The Sea Gull and Seafarer Referral Program has the following rules and guidelines:

- In order for a new camper to be considered as a referral, this form must be completely filled out and submitted to either Camp office. Please limit your submissions to those families that you have specifically recommended to Sea Gull or Seafarer.
- The Sea Gull and Seafarer office will send a letter to the family of the camper being referred to welcome them to Camp and confirm the referral.
- A referral credit will be awarded for each new camper who enrolls in one of our four-week sessions for 2010. A \$250 credit will be awarded for each camper who attends the program and a \$100 credit will be awarded for each camper who is put on the wait list.
- In order for credit to be awarded, the following criteria must be met:
 - The new camper must be enrolled in one of our four-week sessions in the summer of 2010.
 - This must be the new camper's first summer resident camping experience with Camp Sea Gull or Camp Seafarer (in any summer program).
 - New campers who are accepted into our programs must attend Camp for credit to be awarded.
 - In order for the \$100 credit to be awarded for campers who are put on the wait list, they must remain on the wait list until June 15th and must accept a spot if one becomes available (in which case the \$250 credit will be awarded).
 - A new camper may not be referred by their parent or by someone else from the same household.
- Referral credit will be awarded on a first-referral basis, i.e., if two families refer the same new camper, credit will be awarded to the family that submits the completed form first. Credit will be split for forms that arrive on the same day.
- Referral credits will be distributed in one of two ways:
 - If the new camper enrolls prior to March 1, you will receive a credit on your final tuition bill.
 - If the new camper enrolls after March 1, you will receive a rebate at the end of your child's session.
- Awards will consist of credit applied to the tuition of your child or children who are enrolled in any of our programs during the summer of 2010. Credit will not be extended beyond the value of your child or children's tuition for the summer of 2010. Credit cannot be transferred to children of other families.
