Information and Policies

Camp Sea Gull/Camp Seafarer warmly welcome all participants, their families, and support crew to the 2017 USODA Atlantic Coast Championship. Due to the nature of our facilities, it is important that you are aware of the following information and abide by the following policies for the regatta and related events.

- **Camp Sea Gull Office** - The office number is (252) 249-1212.
- **Parking** - All car and trailer parking will be accommodated on-site. We request that except for loading and unloading you leave your car and/or trailer in designated parking areas.
- **Medical Service** - A nurse will be on-site during your stay for minor medical issues.
- **Meals** - The Taylor Mess Hall is open for buffet-style meals during scheduled meal times. Please reference the schedule in the Notice of Race for meal times.
- **Quiet Time** - We ask that participants of all ages be in cabins by 10:00 PM. Quiet time is 10:00 PM - 7:00 AM. Please respect the need for quiet time by the guests on the other side of your cabin.
- **Smoking** - Smoking is not permitted inside any Camp building, facility, or around participants.
- **Alcohol** - No alcoholic beverages are allowed on Camp property.
- **Firearms/Fireworks** - Firearms or fireworks are not permitted on Camp property. Use of the rifle range will only be permitted during Camp staff supervised time.
- **Pets** - Pets may not be brought to or housed on Camp grounds or in Camp facilities.
- **Camp Fires** - Camp Fires are allowed only in designated areas. All fires must be cleared through a member of Camp staff.
- **Swimming** - Swimming in the river, golf lakes or canoe lake is prohibited. Our swim lake is available only at designated times and with staff/lifeguard supervision.
- **Bicycles** - If you choose to bring a bicycle, please park them before sunset. Make sure bikes are out of the pathways of participants who may be walking at night. NC law requires anyone under the age of 16 to wear a helmet. Please note that everything on Camp grounds is within walking distance.
- **Camp Store** - You will be able to purchase Camp clothing and memorabilia, sodas, water, and snacks. You can also purchase common toiletries that you might have left at home. The Camp Store accepts cash, checks or credit card (charging to your card on file).
- **Zipline/Giant Slide** - The Zipline and Giant Slide will be available at designated times to adults and children, however, the equipment must fit securely and properly for safety reasons at any age. Camp reserves the right to not let you participate in these activities.
- **Supervision** - Traditional Camp activities will be available at specified times. Most activities will be staffed, but children under the age of 7 should be with an adult.
- **Locks and Lockers** - Cabins have individual lockers for each participant. Please bring a combination or key lock if you wish to lock your belongings. (See Camp website for pictures of cabins.) Please understand that Camp Sea Gull and Camp Seafarer are not responsible for personal belongings damaged, missing in transit, lost or stolen.
- **Departure** - Please turn off lights and fans, close the shutters, and place bags of trash outside on cabin porches.
- **What to Bring** - Twin bed sheets, blankets, pillow, flashlight, towels, toiletries, water bottle, and sunscreen.
