

FOUR-WEEK PACKING LIST

MAKE SURE ALL ITEMS ARE MARKED WITH YOUR NAME

Masks

4 – 6 Masks that have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric and fit completely over your mouth and nose. Your mask must fit snugly against the sides of your face with no gaps. (Gaiters and Face Shields do not meet the requirements for face coverings based on recent recommendations from the CDC.

Clothing

- 14 T-Shirts
- 14 Pairs of Shorts
- 5 Swimsuits
- 14 Pairs of Underwear
- 14 Pairs of Socks
- 1 Rain Coat
- 1 Long Sleeve T-Shirt or Sweatshirt
- 1 Outfit for Banquet (Collared Shirt, Dress Shorts)
- 1 Pair of Jeans or Casual Slacks
- 1 Pair of River Pants (Nylon Windsuit Pants or Leggings to wear in and out of boats in the river)
- 1 Pair of Tennis Shoes
- 1 Pair of Flip Flops, Sandals, Crocs, river shoes or water shoes
- Sea Gull Camper T-Shirt (Required. Available online or at the Camp Store on Opening Day)

Letter Writing Materials

- Pre-Addressed, Stamped Envelopes (Please place in Ziploc bag to avoid moisture)
- Stationery
- Pens/Pencils

Linens

- 3 Sets of Twin Sheets, 3 Pillow Cases
- 1 Pillow, 1 Lightweight Blanket/Quilt
