Housing Information

Parents and their children will be placed in one of our traditional Camp cabins with other family pairs. Our cabins are open-air, screened buildings with ceiling fans for cooling. If the forecast calls for hot weather, you may want to bring personal fans to help cool your space. There are multiple bunk beds in each cabin for sleeping. Additionally, each cabin has its own indoor bathroom/shower facility as well as individual lockers for storage and a small picnic style table for use. Similar to a duplex, there are two cabins per building at Camp with a shared front porch. The front porch and front yard of the cabin are ideal spaces for your camping chair if you would like to bring it. **Please [visit our website](#) for a virtual tour of our cabins.**

We also have a limited number of climate-controlled cabins, which can be reserved during your registration process for an additional cost. Depending on the particular space, these rooms sleep between four to six people, so they can be shared as well. These spaces sell out quickly and are on a first-come, first-served basis.
