How do I sign-up?

- Go to www.realodiscountdrug.com/camps
- Click "Camp Sea Gull and Camp Seafarer Patient Profile Form"
- Create an account. You may register all children under one profile

Am I required to register my son/daughter, even if he/she isn't currently on medications?

Yes. Often campers are placed on prescription medication by our Camp physician during their stay. Setting up their account with Realo in advance ensures the prescription will be filled quickly and efficiently. The registration process is easy and you can register all of your children at once.

Is there a charge to register my son/daughter for the pharmacy service?

No. Registration is free! Realo will request credit card information in order to charge standard co-pay amounts for any prescriptions filled by Realo.

How do I submit my child's prescriptions to Realo?

Realo pharmacy is equipped to receive prescriptions by mail, phone, fax and electronically. You must obtain a new prescription from your physician for all medications, whether they are prescription only or over-the-counter, that your child will be taking at Camp. **Realo will not be able to transfer prescriptions from your home pharmacy.** You must register your child's medication with Realo at least 30 days prior to your child's Opening Day at Camp. There will be a \$35 late fee charged by Realo for any medication submitted after this time frame.

Will Realo accept my insurance?

Our partner pharmacy accepts most insurances and will accept manufacturer's coupons where eligible. Please call Realo for additional questions.

Can I bring my son/daughter's medications to Camp?

No. To ensure safety, consistency and accuracy of medication administration, **no medications will be accepted on Opening Day.** All medications, including over-the-counter medication, must go through Realo. The only two exceptions are injectable medications or oral contraceptives if your child is mid-pack when Camp begins (refills needed while at Camp for oral contraceptives must be filled by Realo).

What if my son/daughter takes controlled medication?

Realo can fill controlled prescription medications. You must obtain a new prescription from your physician for the controlled medications. **We have provided a letter with specific information regarding the process of filling a controlled medication for Camp use. You can present this letter to your child's physician to facilitate this process.** If you have additional questions please call Realo for assistance.

Can I bring my son/daughter's vitamins and/or herbal supplements on Opening Day?

No. In order to ensure safety, consistency and accuracy of medication administration, all medications, including over the counter medications or herbal supplements must go through Realo.

Can I bring "as needed" medications for my son/daughter to Camp on Opening Day?

No. In order to ensure safety, consistency and accuracy of medication administration, all camper medications must go through Realo, even if these medications are prescribed on an as-needed basis.

Can I bring my son/daughter's holistic remedies on Opening Day?

Realo pharmacy does not dispense holistic remedies so we ask that you please contact Camp to discuss your specific situation.

My son/daughter will need allergy shots while at Camp. Can I bring this on Opening Day?

Yes. You may bring injectable medication on Opening Day.

My son/daughter has an allergy that requires them to carry an EpiPen. Do we need to order this from Realo or may we bring it to Camp?

Camp Sea Gull and Camp Seafarer have EpiPens strategically placed throughout Camp areas and are also available for off-site trips, should the need arise for them to be used. **We recommend that you leave your child's EpiPen at home.**

My son/daughter was placed on an antibiotic right before Opening Day? Can I bring it to Camp?

Yes. You may bring an antibiotic that was prescribed and filled one week or less before Opening Day to Camp. Any refills of this antibiotic must go through Realo.

Will I be able to verify that my son/daughter's medication was delivered accurately when I bring him/her to Camp?

Yes. You may go to the Health Center on Opening Day and Health Center staff will assist you with verification. A pharmacist will also be on-site in the Health Center to answer questions.

How will my son/daughter's remaining medication be returned at the end of Camp?

All medication will be placed in blister packages by Realo. Any medication not administered will be placed in a sealed envelope and delivered to the camper at his/her cabin on Closing Day. Morning medication will be administered prior to camper's departure from Camp that day.
